Gifts for local foster children

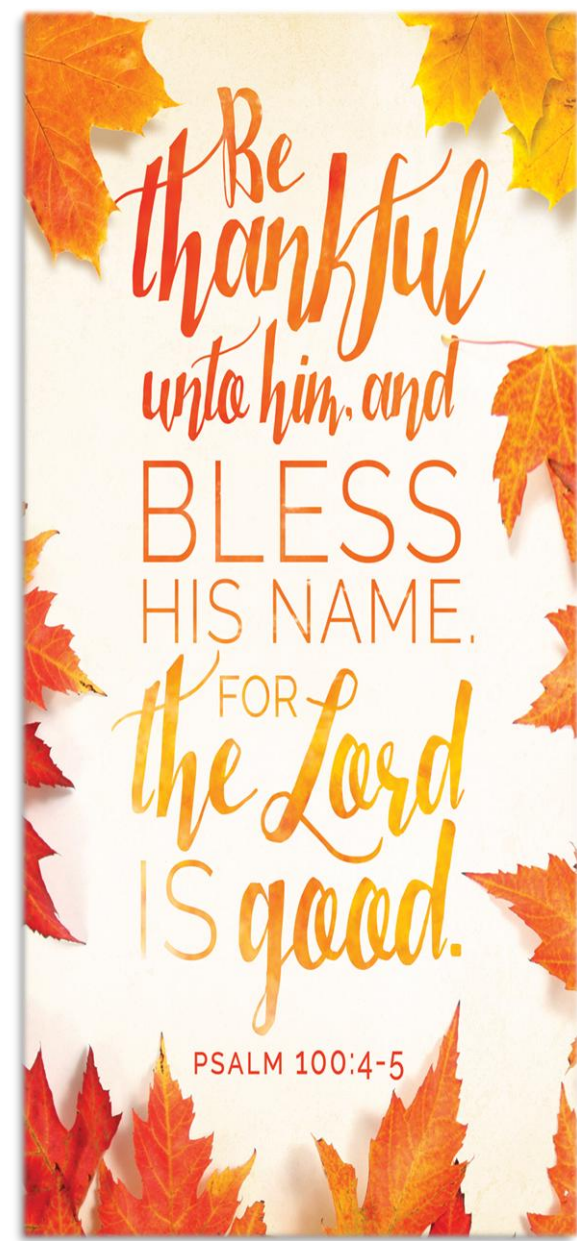
